Lush boreal forest is being gobbled up at an alarming rate. More than 19,000 fossil fuel permits have been issued to date. Impacts from all of these projects threaten to destroy Beaver Lake Cree Nation's way of life – polluting and fragmenting the land and waters that have sustained them for millennia.
